A Toast to Nick, Certainly One of the Nice Guys

20 miles west of Foggia, nestled among the Beechnut trees is the town of Faeto in the province of Foggia, Apulia region, is where Nick Pavia was born and raised before immigrating to the US in 1965. He later married in 1979 to wife Carolyn and raised three sons who all live in Rochester and volunteer at the Italian-American Sport Club.

After spending quality time raising his three boys, Rick, Robert and Lyle, including coaching and supporting them in playing soccer, Nick had more time know to focus on the growth of the IASC.

Retired from Delphi in 2006, Nick worked virtuously to help the IASC from growing its fledgling membership of 110 members.

With no place to call home, the IASC kept up with events and scheduled meetings wherever possible. Nick initiated and oversaw the distribution of food and beverages including set up, clean up and transportation of food and beverages both at the Chili Ave and Fireman's Hall locations.

“Someone had to transfer all the liquor and food between locations and we were really struggling to maintain membership,” says the board member since 1998.

When time came to finally find a home, the board decided that in order for the club to survive, it needed to go back to its roots and keep the club sports-oriented.

“We needed a place with a soccer field and with the help of an excavator, in 2002 I cleared the trees for two years straight, he said. Nick would leave work and come right to the club. He continued, “We did not have the money to build this place and had lots of donations.” ‘

After one year, the IASC location was constructed and Nick assisted in laying the foundation.

Currently, Nick maintains the field at 1650 Buffalo with his zero turn mower and also responsible for striping the lines on the field.

Also, Nick has managed the bar since 2003 including ordering stock and any repairs needed to the coolers or coffee machine, and is glad he does not have to transport the liquor as he did in the past.

Nick is pleased to be part of growing the club from over 110 members to over 600 strong. More importantly, he believes the club will grow because, “there are more women members,’ and hopes, “to see the next generation continue supporting and being active in the club.”

Ferrari: A Racing Myth

How many companies have a name as powerful as Ferrari?

From a small factory in Maranello, near Modena (Italy), a legend was created that races on wheels with engines that are a work of art.

Enzo Ferrari started the company with a vision to compete with the biggest names on the planet, such as Maserati, Alfa Romeo, and Mercedes. It eventually defeated all of them.

In 2011, sales were up 5.4 percent. The 6,573 units delivered to dealers were Ferrari's most ever. Net revenues topped \$2.6 billion, up 7.9 percent, and profits rose 15.8 percent to \$850 million. *Robb Report* named Ferrari's "458 Italia" *Car of the Year for 2011*.

Why all the success? Exciting products, reputation, heritage, and fantasy, says Marco Mattiacci, CEO of Ferrari North America. Ferrari doesn't sell just cars, it sells dreams, passion, and total experience (*doesn't that sound like a true Italian product?*). Some examples: Ferrari dealerships host Sunday-morning parties to watch "Formula One" races; The company offers racing schools exclusively to Ferrari owners; Dealers know Ferrari's 32,000 North American owners by name.

The average age of a Ferrari customer in North America is 47 (*in China it's closer to 32*); 45% of them are entrepreneurs, and 45% have a PhD or an MBA.

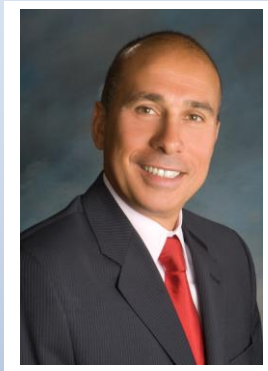
